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1. INTRODUCTION TO THE UNIVERSITY, THE CAMPUS, AND THE DEPARTMENT

The history of the institution goes back to the year 1857 when Maharaja Ranbir Singh, seeking to fulfil his dream of making the state as a centre of Sanskrit learning and knowledge (Kashi of the North), established a Sanskrit Mahavidyalaya in the premises of Shri Raghunath Temple at Jammu.

That very institution was taken over in 1971 by Rashtriya Sanskrit Sansthan, New Delhi, established in 1970 as per the recommendations of the Sanskrit Commission of 1956, for the protection and promotion of Sanskrit language and literature. The new institutions were called (1) Shri Ranbir Kendriya Sanskrit Vidyapeetha, Jammu. Similar institutions were established by the Sansthan at (2) New Delhi, (3) Jaipur, Rajasthan, (4) Bhopal, MP, (5) Mumbai, Maharashtra, (6) Sringeri, Karnataka, (7) Guruvayur, Kerala, (8) Tirupati, Andhra Pradesh, (9) Puri, Odisha, (10) Agartala, Tripura, (11) Lucknow, UP (12) Prayagraj, UP (formerly Alahabad), (13) Devprayag and (14) Balahar, HP. Out of the above, New Delhi Campus and Tirupati campuses were later converted into independent institutions with Deemed University status, and came to be called Shri Lal Bahadur Kendriya Sanskrit Vidhyapeetha, and Kendriya Sanskrit Vidyapeetha, Tirupati. Hence, Rashtriya Sanskrit Sansthan was given Deemed university status in 2002 with 12 campuses (including the Headquarter office).

12 December, 2019 was a letter day in the history of this institution when the Parliament of India passed an act whereby Rashtriya Sanskrit Sansthan was declared to be a Central University under the name of Central Sanskrit University, Delhi. Accordingly, the university started to function under the new name and status on 30 April, 2020.

Department of Modern Subjects

Although, most of the subjects covered under the Department of Modern Subjects today were already being taught at the campus since the inception of the institute in 1971, they were all brought under one department in 2011, and thus the Department of Modern Subjects was created at the Central and Campus levels.

The senior-most member of the department is designated as the Head of the Department. At present, the Department of Modern Subjects is headed by Associate Professor Sharat Chander Sharma (English). He is also the Dean of the Faculty of Modern Subjects and Head of the Department of English at the central level.

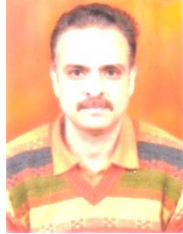

5. THE SUBJECTS OFFERED BY THE DEPARTMENT

The Department of Modern Subjects, Sh. Ranbir Campus, Jammu, offers the following subjects:-

1. English
2. Hindi
3. Dogri
4. History
5. Political Science
6. Computer Science
7. Environment Science
8. Physical Education

English and **Computer Science** are compulsory subjects and are taught at prak shastri(intermediate) and Shastri(Graduation) level. **Environmental Science** is being taught as a compulsory subject as per the directions of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India. Only 50 classes are conducted in Shastri III year (25 classes each in the V and VI semesters). Hindi, Dogri, Political Science and History are again offered to the students as optional subjects at prak shastri(intermediate) and Shastri(Graduation) level. Students can choose either **Dogri** or **Hindi**, and either **History** or **Political Science**. As per NEP 2020 English literature is also introduced in the Campus as Generic Elective subject.

Medium of instructions is Hindi, except in English and Dogri, although, the students have the option of writing their exams in English as well.

In addition to their academic work, the teachers of the Department make a significant contribution to the other work related to the campus. The computer teachers provide a valuable support to the office by managing the campus website, handling campus emails, especially the correspondence from the Headquarter. The other teachers of the Department contribute by organizing sports events, cultural events, and other campus activities.

7. Admission Process

The Department has no role in admission of students. The students to Prak Shastri (equiv. Higher Secondary) I year, and Shastri (equiv. B.A.) I Semester is done through Entrance Test conducted at campus level. The successful candidates are offered the subjects of their choice depending upon their availability. The details of the students admitted to the Department during the last five years are as under:

8. Syllabus revision

Syllabi of the subjects are revised at the Headquarter level. The faculty of the Department are invited to the Headquarter from time to time to participate in the revision exercise as per requirement. There has been no revision of the syllabus since the grant of Central University status.

9. Academic Achievements during the last five years (2017-18 to 2021-2022)

All the teachers of the Department have been taking part in various academic research and literary activities and achieved the result of more than 95% in semester examinations. Even during the times of COVID pandemic, teachers continued with their related activities, using online resources. The details of their academic, research and literary activities have been placed on the Google drive and links provided.

10. Learning Resources in the Department.

A. Library – Central Library and the Departmental Library

The students and teachers of the Department are members of the Central Library which houses more than 41,759 books. In addition to that, 600 books are available in the Book Bank. In addition to the Central Library, the students and teachers can also borrow books from the Departmental Library. There are 414 books on modern subjects in the Departmental Library covering all the 7 subjects in the Department namely, English, Hindi, Dogri, Political Science, History, Computer Science and Physical Education. The library is managed by the faculty of the Department.

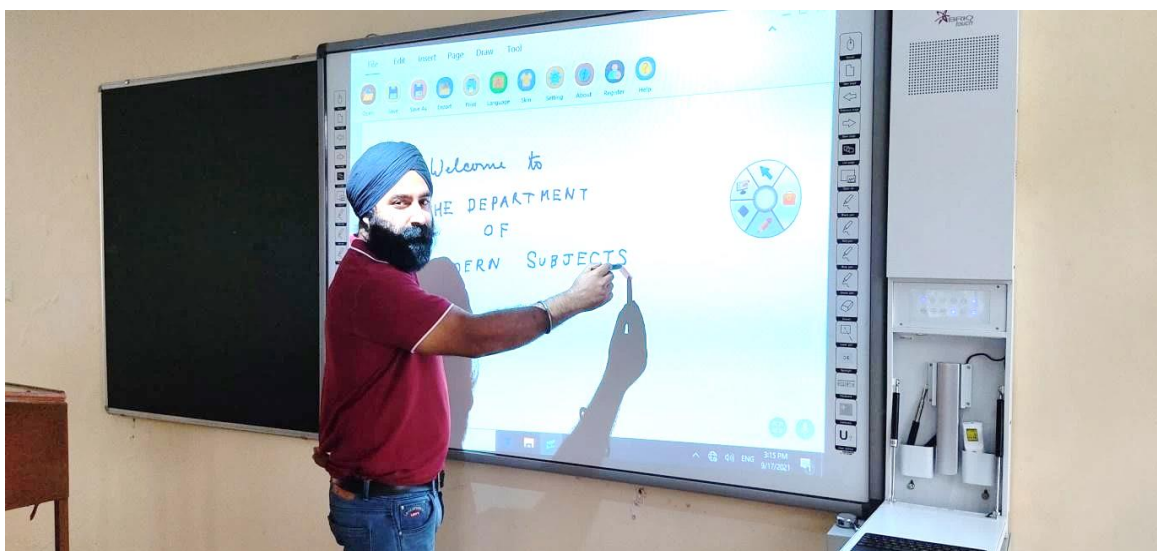
The Departmental Library also houses a number of Dictionaries which include: English to English, English to Hindi, English to Sanskrit, Sanskrit to Hindi and Hindi to Dogri dictionaries.

B. Computer Lab

The Department has an air-conditioned Computer Lab for the use of the students and staff of the Campus. The laboratory is primarily used for imparting practical training to the students of the campus, because Computer Science is a compulsory subject for all the undergraduate students. In addition to the above, the Computer Lab is also used for various office related work assigned to the Computer Teachers.

Computer section of the Department has 18 computers with internet facility. There is also a Wi-Fi modem which provides broadband internet facility to the computers and select mobile phones in the premises.

C. Smart Class



A big 50'x50' room has been allotted to the Smart Class of the Department of Modern subjects with the seating capacity for 50 students. The equipment has a smart board with close throw projector and an in-built computer and control console featuring Whiteboard and Visualizer facilities. It also has laptop connectivity and internet connectivity with LAN. The department has enhanced a lot of resources for teaching and research in the last five years. These include procurement of computers, digital video camera, home theatre sound system, increase in the number of books and DVDs/CDs in the library etc.

11. Availability and Improvement in Teaching Resources

The teachers of the Department, in addition to extra duties assigned to them, prioritise teaching in their routine work. They also make use of technology.

12. Use of Modern Teaching Techniques

The department has 18 computer with internet facility which the teachers and students can use for academic purposes. There is a provision for seminar presentation by individual students on topics related to the subjects taught. There are also provisions for students for tutorials and discussions among the students and teachers. In addition, the students are sent to field trips, so that they get exposed to advanced institutions and eminent academicians/scholars besides gaining an insight into the environmental problems being faced by the society at large.

The teachers of the Department use modern teaching techniques such as PPTs, audio and video materials in addition to class room teaching. The students are also provided notes to facilitate their understanding of the subject. In view of the restrictions imposed due to the Corona pandemic, the faculty of the department made a dextrous use of latest techniques using computers, mobile phones, internet, Facebook, Google meet, zoom, etc. to conduct online classes, and tests.

13. Contribution in personal and academic advice to the students

The faculty of the department is active in providing personal and academic advice to the students. An example in this regard is the Sushant Rohilla intervention scheme.

14. Departmental Development Programmes and details of the Teachers.

The details of the teachers have been provided in their Personal profile. The faculty members of the department help to conduct various workshops, awareness programmes, training programmes especially translation skills development for enhancement of knowledge base.

15. Co-operation with other departments and institutions at the international and national levels (during the last five years).

Academic scholars of excellence in other institutions are regularly invited to participate in the various seminars and special lecture series. The details have been uploaded and links provided..

16. Details of the publication, seminars etc. by the members of the Department.

Details of faculty development programs and teachers who benefited during the past five years detail of which has been given in the personal profile of the teachers. Many of the teachers have either attended seminars/symposia mostly at the National Level, or attended various workshops devoted to teaching and research.

17. Participation of the Department in activities relating to the development of the University.

The faculty of the Department makes significant contribution to the development of the campus in holding of the various functions such as Hindi fortnight, Vigilance Awareness Week, Unity Day, Sports activities, Cultural activities etc.

18. The Process of Continuous evaluation of the students.

Students are continuously assessed by conducting regular internal assessment tests, seminars and home assignments. In addition, tutorials and extempore speeches are organized from time to time in order to build up the capacities of the students. All the teachers take active part in academic and personal counselling of the students. This includes counselling for seminar presentation, preparation for sessional and semester examinations, preparation for competitive examinations, preparation for various kinds of public speaking competitions, etc.

19. Placement record of the students and the Department's contribution therein.

Although the students are taught subjects under Modern Department only until their graduation and there is no post graduate course introduced in the university related to Modern Subjects, students are given counselling regarding their career and a number of students are placed in Army as *Dharam Gurus*, teachers in schools and higher education department, police and even some of the students are trying to enter into civil services. The record of which is maintained centrally.

20. Future plans for the next five years.

This department is thriving hard to attain excellence. The department will proliferate to take up Interdisciplinary & interdepartmental Research Projects and Publish Research Projects, Seminar and workshops proceedings. the department will be trying to arrange following activities for the development of the students and the teachers as well.
